2005 Graham Squance Award

On Friday October 21st we were delighted to be able to present the Folk Song and Dance Society of Victoria's annual Graham Squance Memorial Award for services to the folk community to singer DUNCAN BROWN.

Duncan's citation reads as follows: "For excellence in the performance and promotion of traditional and unaccompanied singing, and for longstanding service to the Folk Music community in an organisational capacity.'

Duncan has been involved in the Melbourne folk scene since the mid nineteen-sixties. He was involved in running a number of folk clubs in Melbourne and was treasurer of the forerunner of the FSDSV for four years from around 1969 – 1972. He performed in a number of iconic harmony groups, the best known perhaps being "Canterbury Fair". He also sang for around eight years in a duo with his friend Alison - "Duncan and Alison" were much revered for their beautiful harmonies.

After moving with his family to Guildford, he became involved in the running if the Guildford Folk Club, and has stayed in that role for the past thirteen years. Duncan is perhaps best known for his rousing session singing and his more-than-thirty-year singing partnership with Danny Spooner. It was Danny who both nominated him for the award and presented it to him on the 21st.

Congratulations Duncan and long may we hear you sing.
