FIONA WHITE'S CD LAUNCH - "MYTHS OF TIME"

She has sung both solo, with husband Kenny, and with others such as Danny Spooner, Gordon MacIntyre and Martin Wyndham-Read since the early days of folk clubs in Melbourne.

VALE RANDALL PERCY.

We have received the sad news of the death on Thursday May 4th of long-time folk identity Randall Percy among friends and family in Northern Ireland. Randall lived in Melbourne for many years, then in Chewton, Central Victoria, from the early nineties until late last year when, due to the increasing effects of his cancer, he sold up and moved back to his native Ireland to be with family in what were to become the last few months of his life.

Randall was a stalwart of the former Dan O'Connell Folk Club in Melbourne. He took over its running in 1976 and continued the traditions for which it was famous well into the 1980's. He was always willing to give his time and efforts for the benefit of the folk movement, particularly at festivals such as Chiltern and Maldon.

His encouragement of new musical talent was much appreciated by the performers he helped along the way. Randall was instrumental also in bringing many of the world's best performers to Australia, and in the development of a national touring circuit which made such visits possible.

Randall was awarded Folk Victoria's Graham Squance Memorial Award for services to the folk community in 1981.
