From the President

Greetings all. It's been a while since you heard from us and meanwhile there has been a feast of great Autumn music happening both here and interstate. The Brunswick, Port Fairy, National and Apolllo Bay festivals have come and gone as well as the usual array of performances in this "city of entertainment"!

Now winter is upon us, and the picture for Folk Victoria for 2008 remains unclear. Those folk who expressed interest in re-starting a Folk Club in a new venue have yet to meet so I can't give you any news in that direction. ARE YOU CONCERNED??? I have had only one person phone or email in the whole six month expressing that they missed the folk club or wondering what was happening.

SO, <u>is</u> there any need or interest?? What is it that keeps you paying your membership year by year?? At last year's AGM it was decided that:

"In **May** of next year we will review the situation, and if no extra assistance or support has been offered by then, we will be giving a last plea to members. If no change by **July**, we will call a **Special General Meeting** to consider winding up the Society."

The Committee is now of the opinion that we **value** the organisation, history and infrastructure to such an extent that we would like to **keep the Society going** for at least another year in the hope that new ideas and new blood will emerge. We do value our "style" of presenting folk music — **in a quiet but friendly listening atmosphere** of respect for both the performer **and** the listener.

We would offer the **2008/09** membership at a discount rate of **\$15** and still be involved in a variety of projects.

The **membership fee** will still be put to good use, despite there being no folk club at present. For example:

- Upkeep of website
- Upkeep of computer
- · Other admin costs
- Production and mailing of newsletter
- Donations and/or loans to worthy folk-related projects.
- Society membership of various other folk-related societies which feed us information to put in our newsletters.
- The costs associated in the production of the Graham Squance Memorial Award certificate and the upkeep of the book

There will also be **one-off events**, even if a folk club does not eventuate for a while, for example:

- Saturday July 26th Tea Dance with TSDAV
- September or October Graham Squance Memorial Award Night

- December Traditional Christmas concert and Carols night
- March Involvement in the 2009 Brunswick Music Festival
