STOP PRESS - VALE JOE

I have just received word of the very sad passing of one of our most talented long-time musical friends **JOE PAOLACCI**. Joe was admitted to Box Hill Hospital on January 23rd, diagnosed, I believe, with extensive and aggressive cancer, and passed away today, **Friday January 30**th, with family and friends around him. Our sincere condolences go to his three children and to his extended family and loved ones.

Joe was a talented guitarist, singer and songwriter, who came into folk music through uni and played in bush bands and sessions in those early days. Among other bands and musicians, he played with Poteen, Captain Moonlight, and in duos with both John McAuslan (I remember their magic

version of "Sally Wheatley") and Enda Kenny. He also performed solo and released some tapes but, sadly, no CDs. Maybe someone will do a compilation. I got the feeling he most loved sitting around and singing and playing with friends, sharing, learning and yarning!

All of us who knew Joe will of course remember him in different ways. As a music teacher I remember Joe in the 80's as head of the Education Department's recording studio. I took groups in there for a few years to record and Joe was always fantastic with the kids. He was very chuffed when I taught the choir his song "Tall and True". I still have the recording – and still sing the song, along with another of my favourites of his, "Southern Cross".

Joe had his good and bad times like the rest of us, but I will always remember his mesmerising voice and gentle ways. Many friends came to sing and play at his bed during the past week – and I'm sure that would have put much sweetness into his final journey. Vale Joe!
