#### From the President

Greetings all once again. It took a while to recover from the fabulous National Folk Festival in Canberra over Easter. Many of the highlight bands and musicians I had already seen at Port Fairy or other festivals but I found them no less exciting and entertaining for that. Andrew Pattison's Troubadour Wine Bar venue was a hit, as always, and the almostall-night session bar was jumping with sessions in every nook and cranny! It really is a festival that caters for all tastes, whether you are lover of dance, singing, music, poetry, history, catching up on friends, sessioning, or just veging out at the many venues! I felt, though, that it was, like many festivals, getting a bit too crowded and hope they can resolve some related issues before next year.

We were saddened to hear just prior to the festival that Lucy Stockdale succumbed to the pancreatic cancer which had laid her low and many of our folk friends were able to go to her funeral to mourn and to and celebrate her life along with her family. Those of you who receive our regular emails will have already read the words I have printed below, but there may be some of you who weren't even aware of her death. A Tea Dance is being organised in her honour on Sunday May 31st at the Brunswick Town Hall – see later in the newsletter.

We have another, very tragic, death to pass on to those who are not email readers - that of Folk Vic member Thomas Orange, who became ill whilst on holiday in Sicily (also see below). Our love and thoughts go out to the families and friends of these two much loved people.

Margot Hitchcock is doing well following her stroke and should be out of Royal Talbot very soon. She is determined to be at Lucy's Memorial Tea Dance! Gail Nicholson was unfortunately informed that her lung cancer has spread, but she remains optimistic and managed to make it to the National Festival between chemo treatments - it was good to see her smiling face as usual at the Wine Bar!

The Melbourne Folk Club continues to power along each Saturday with many great artists having already performed there. Don't forget to check the website each week to catch up with the latest, and if you haven't made it down to the Grand View vet. do vourself a favour and spend a wintry afternoon in the warmth with friends and music.

#### VALE LUCY STOCKDALE

Many of you knew Lucy, but for those who didn't know her so well. I have copied below some details of her folk involvement from the Folk Victoria "Graham Squance Memorial Award" book. She received the award in 2002.

"Lucy's involvement with the Folk Song and Dance Society dates from the late 1970's. For some years she was involved in the running of the FSDSV's Sunday afternoon dances at the Carlton Community Centre. Her own memory was hazy on the exact dates. but Lucy served as president of the FSDSV for several years in the late 1980's.

Lucy shared her considerable knowledge of and enthusiasm for social dance with a number of other organisations. She had been involved with the Colonial Dancers since the mid 70's and the Traditional and Social Dance Association of Victoria since the early 80's. She was instrumental in facilitating the Colonial Dancers Display Group's trip to the Edinburgh Festival in 1988, contributing her skills as a dance choreographer as well as organiser and leader.

More recently, Lucy and Shirley Andrews organised the Victorian Dance Assembly for the TSDAV. This has been a monthly teaching and learning session for dancers. Lucy and Shirley's aims were to research old dance books, decipher and interpret the dance instructions, try them out with a group of dancers, then video and record the steps. Following Shirley's death in 2001, Lucy continued these sessions.

Lucy also took on the task of sorting and cataloguing Shirley's extensive dance collection, for which purpose the FSDSV donated a sum of money. The aim is to present the collated collection to the National Library so that it will become accessible to future generations of dancers and researchers."

From what I can gather, Lucy had already made arrangements to pass on all her dance materials, and had made arrangements for her 19-year-old daughter Elizabeth to be cared for by relatives. Lucy will be greatly missed.

#### VALE THOMAS ORANGE

We were shocked to hear of the recent unexpected death whilst on holiday of another of our Folk Victoria members, Thomas Orange. Thomas was a great friend to many people in the music circles, a music lover and active with the Colonial Dancers. He was travelling overseas with his girlfriend and both of them began feeling unwell with a cold whilst in Sicily. His girlfriend improved, so I gather, but with Thomas the bug rapidly progressed to pneumonia. He was unable to access sufficient medical treatment and by the time he was able to get to a hospital it was too late and he died

from the complications which had taken a firm hold. It was a huge shock as he was relatively young and fit. I do not know any further details at this stage, but from what I can gather his family have not yet been able to bring him back to Australia. Our hearts go out to his girlfriend, and to all his family and friends.


