

#### ANDY BAYLOR

## "Possum Stole the Pumpkin"



Double CD ABCD-09:

Melbourne-born multi-instrumentalist, singer, writer and composer Andy Baylor is one of the country's finest and most versatile and adaptable musical practitioners. He moves easily from Cajun to Western Swing, Tex-Mex to Rockabilly, Blues to Jazz, Country to Rock, Old-Timey to Folk. Since the 1970's Andy has been instrumental in spreading previously little-known musical sounds across Australia, from the big city lights to far-flung remote communities.

Andy's lean lanky figure cradling a guitar, mandolin or fiddle is a familiar sight around Melbourne. He's a cool and assured yet unassuming front-man. Space, timing, consummate skill and expression are the hallmarks of his playing. He obviously plays for love and celebration of the music. Showiness and flurries of frenzied notes play no part in his performance style.

Andy's band involvements have included: Hit and Run (country rock) The Autodrifters ("ocker-billy"), The Blue Rockets and the Honeydrippers (soul and blues), the Dancehall Racketeers (Western Swing, Cajun, zydeco, rockabilly, country, hillbilly and blues), Andy Baylor's Cajun Combo, various formations of the Baylor Brothers Band with brothers Donal and Peter, and more recent involvements with the Hometown Prophets and the Charcoal Club.

In freelance mode, the list of Australian and international artists he has played and toured with is impressive and includes David Grisman, Flaco Jiminez, Dewey Balfa, Jimmy McGriff, Bob Dylan, Slim Dusty and Kerri Simpson. Andy has spent time in America honing his skills and his knowledge of styles, but always seems to be able on return to infuse his music with a uniquely Australian flavour.

Andy has released and played on numerous recordings. "Possum Stole the Pumpkin" is one of his latest projects, released in 2009. It is a double-CD collection of fiddle tunes he has composed during the last few years, all recorded between 2006 and 2008. In Andy's words: "Many tunes were written in Layafette, Louisiana, and were inspired by the Cajun and Creole music of that region. Others have come to me on my travels around Australia and bear the names of the places where they were composed. Still others have been named for people that I know and love. This music is a celebration of simplicity".

Not being a fiddle aficionado, I initially approached this recording with a little trepidation. As well as a wish to put his tunes out into the ether, the project was a part fulfilment of Andy's Master of Arts Project and I wondered whether it would "cut it" as an entertaining CD. I need not have worried. Though many tracks are pared back to just Andy's fiddle and one percussion instrument, I found the overall variety well-balanced and thoroughly enjoyable.

The exuberant, insistent rhythms of Cajun, Creole and Zydeco inspired dance music are interspersed evenly amongst gentler melodies and waltzes. Some tunes have a Celtic, Old-Timey or Mexican feel to them. The balance extends to textures. Fiddler Sophie Dunn joins Andy for some delightful fiddle duos. Denis Close plays an astonishing variety of percussion instruments (conventional, African and "way-out-there"), and on some tracks the fiddle is accompanied by Andy himself on guitars or mandolin, Leigh Barker on double bass, and/or Peter Baylor or Sam Lemann on guitars. Andy even exercises his voice on the delightful "Amade Played Accordion" on CD 2.

Andy does make available the thesis which goes with "Possum Stole the Pumpkin", and if you are a fiddle player or interested in the topic I'm sure Andy would make it available to you. However, if, like me, you just want to enjoy a "celebration of music and simplicity" playing in your home or car, it comes highly recommended from this music lover!
