Andrew, The Troubadour, and the National Festival

We were shocked to learn a few weeks back that Andrew Pattison and the Troubadour Wine Bar had been "dumped" from the National Folk Festival. The new director apparently felt more money could be made for the festival by running their own wine bar – in complete ignorance of Andrew's 34 years of experience in running music venues, and the incredible rapport he builds with musicians, singers, poets and storytellers. The Troubadour Wine Bar is the heart and hub of the Festival, and would be nothing without the committed performers, volunteers, workers, friends, audience and extended "family" that Andrew and Heather attract.

However, the Festival hadn't bargained on Andrew's enormous support base, and the sheer volumes of emails and letters sent in protest have prompted the festival to negotiate for the return of the Troubadour.

Whether this will be an ongoing agreement may depend on our ongoing support. I urge people to contact the Festival to must remind them of the legacy of the Troubadour Wine Bar and its contribution to our folk music culture. Tell them that a Wine Bar run by festival volunteers without Andrew's years of experience in running music venues would be a soulless affair indeed and possibly alienate a huge number of dedicated lovers and supporters of the National Festival. Andrew would appreciate knowing of your support too.
