The Blues Collection

A set of 90 quality gloss 12-page magazines, each detailing the history and works of a different prominent blues music performer or group.

Originally each magazine was accompanied by a CD or cassette featuring the particular artist performing 18 of their best numbers.

These numbers are listed and discussed in each magazine, but the magazines do not contain any sheet music nor words of songs.

The donor of this magazine collection kept the CD's / cassettes but the printed lists of song titles in the magazines would allow most songs to be tracked down on the internet.

A scanned list of the performers is provided below, with a reference to the particular magazine number.

An overall alphabetic index of all the songs is in Issue 90.

The collection was intended to be filed in 6 hard-cover binders but we received the collection in 4 binders.

The following issues were planned but never printed, for "legal reasons: 42,48,54,58,60,63,66.

Also missing from the collection are 64 and 82.

If you would like to remove individual issues from the binders, please do it carefully so as not to damage the binders.

If in doubt, ask for help in removing or re-inserting issues in the binders.

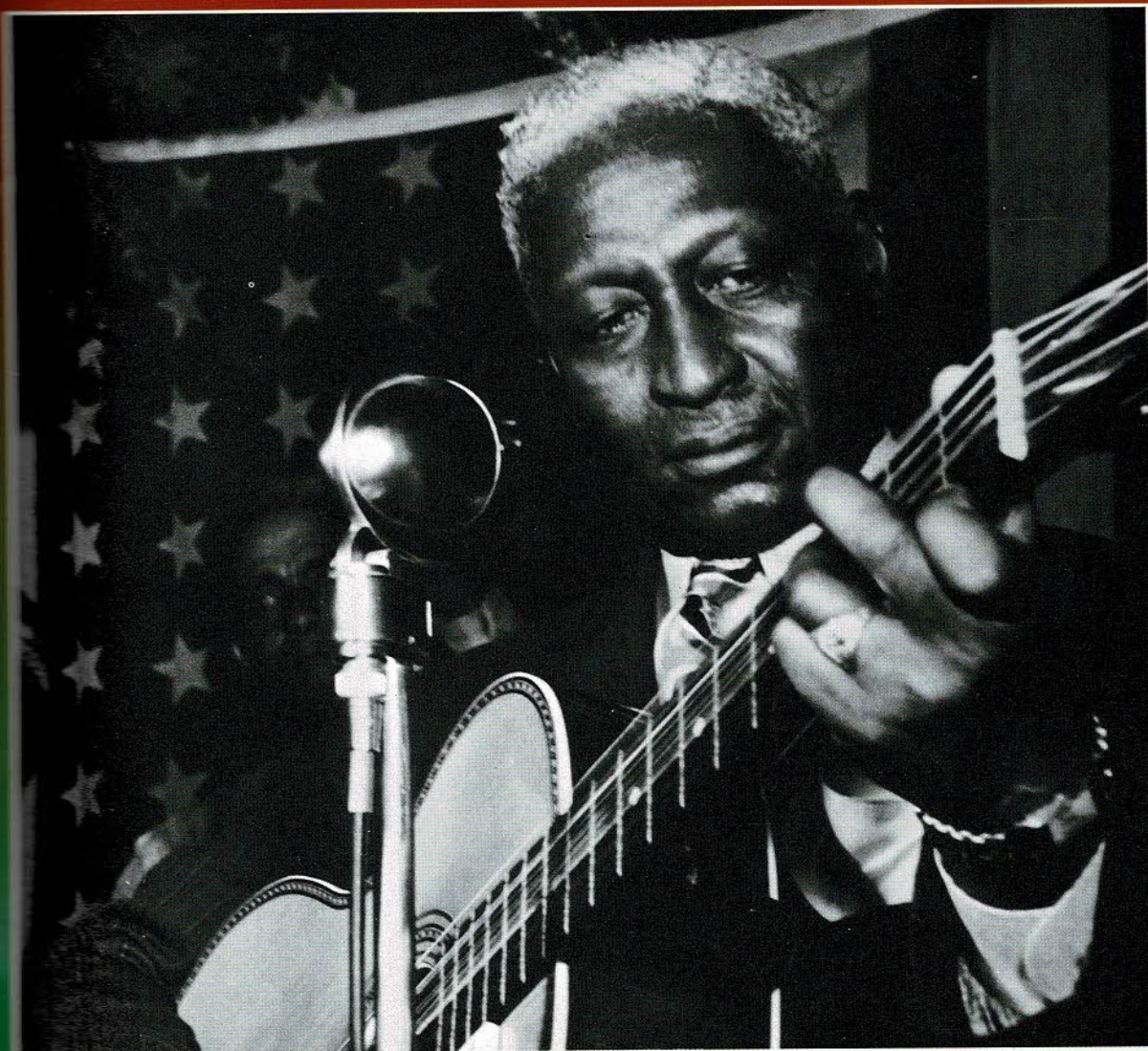
